

Rucha's remarkable achievements continued with selections for prestigious events like the Khelo India University Games in Bangalore and the All India University Games in Rohtak—a first in Shivaji University's history. Most recently, as captain in 2023, she led the university to a bronze medal at the Ashwamedh Inter-University Games in Nagpur and participated in the Mini Olympics, once again demonstrating her leadership and prowess.
